Floating Markets

Trading close to a RCTA Floating market? Would you like to join us?

Our floating markets are organised and run by volunteers from the Association in conjunction with the Canal & River Trust. To meet our insurance conditions all boats trading within the restricted mooring zone set up by CRT must be paid attendees of the market event and must agree to the market terms and conditions. If there are spare places at the market and you would like to join us, please speak to the market manager. It's very straightforward to join on-line but if you have any problems with the process, the market manager may be able to help or will be able to refer you to someone who can.

You will need to:

- Visit our web site <https://www.rcta.org.uk/> and complete the registration form.
- Pay the membership subscription of £10.
- Provide evidence of a current CRT Roving Trader Licence (an uploaded photograph will do).
- Demonstrate that you are insured to trade and provide the name of your Insurer, the policy number and Limit of Indemnity.
- If you are planning to sell food you will need the appropriate Food Hygiene clearance and will need to display it at the time of trading.
- Read and comply with RCTA's market terms and conditions.
- Confirm that you have read and will comply with the market safety risk assessment.
- Pay the market fee of £20.

If you are having difficulty getting on-line at the market location, providing the above evidence and paying the subscription and market fee to the Market Manager may be acceptable in certain situations and if the overall Market Co-ordinator has given approval.

Tagging on to a market

If you are taking advantage of a market by mooring just outside the restricted mooring zone set up by CRT you might wish to join the Association but if not, we would be grateful if you could let the market manager know your intention to trade as this will avoid confusion. A donation to RCTA based on your takings would be welcome. RCTA is a volunteer led self-help organisation whose key aim is to promote opportunities for the community of roving traders.
